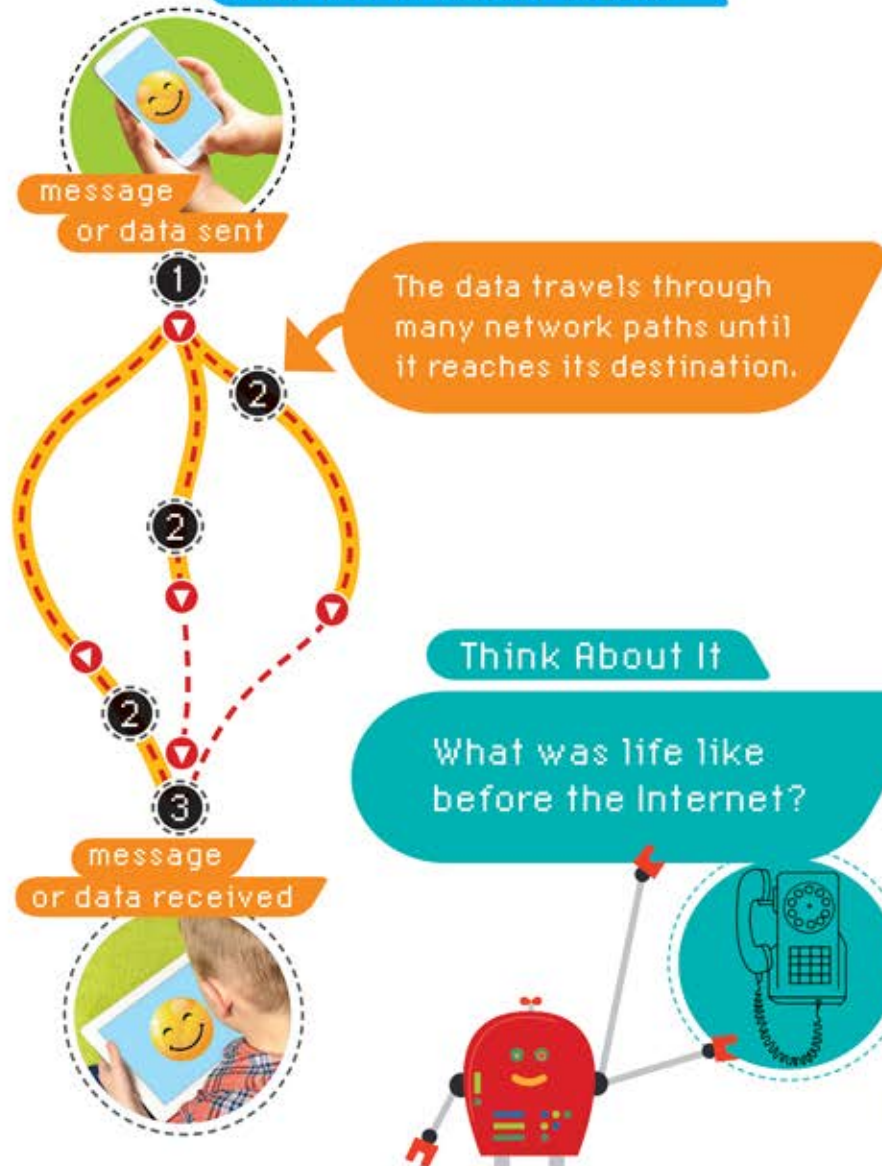




The Internet

The Internet allows you to look at websites. You can visit them by using a browser. A browser lets you look through—or browse—the Internet. You can find new websites by typing what you are looking for into a search bar.

STORYBOARDING A HOME PAGE

Before building a website, you need a plan. You need to create a storyboard or sketch of your website. Pretend you are going to create a shopping website. You are going to sell clothes that do not fit you anymore. Make sure the website gives your customers all the information they need to purchase your clothes.

▶ **Materials Needed:**
plain paper or graph paper, pencil

STEPS

- 1 Make a list of information to include on your website. For example, you want people to know where you are located, how to contact you, and what types of clothing you are selling.
- 2 Draw a picture of what your website's home page would look like.
- 3 Draw lines underneath it to the other pages on the website: for example, About Me, Clothing for Sale, Location, and Contact. You might have separate pages for different types of clothing: for example, Shirts, Pants, and Shoes.
